Module Class Suffix: the string that gets appended to the module if you want to assign more specific, individual styling. (leave it blank)

Max Items per Page: You can play with this Parameter to fit it right.

Max Item per Row: Best is the same as Items per Page

Categories Selection: Press // STRING // to select more then one category

Articles Sorted by:: Select your Article ordering.

Limit Items: How much article should be shown in the main slideshow area.

Title mac chars: Select how much chars should be displayed in the header area of your slideshow.

Description Max Char: 100 chars are recommed, otherwise you have to change the // top // syntax at the css from the module.

Play Style: Select your sliding effect.

Interval: Set your Slideshow intervat in milliseconds

Animation Transition: Type of transition. Options are Fading, Zooming, Panning, Combo - Ken Burns Effects, Push, and Wipe

Auto Start: If No, youre slideshow start only by clicked the navigator item.

Display Button: coming soon ! Current no function

Thumbnail height and width: Select the thumbnail size of the navigator


Height: The height of the slideshow in px. (230px are supported)

Width: The width of the slideshow in px. (900px are supported)
